This matter is taken up by hybrid mode.

The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to review the posting of the petitioner at Astaranga P.S. for the 2nd time contrary to the instructions and guidelines of the Government and give posting at any place at Police head quarter or town control room or Court or in the police traffic.
3. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner may be permitted to file a fresh representation before the opposite party no.2 highlighting the grievances and direction may be given to consider the same within a stipulated time, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.
4. As agreed by learned counsel for the parties, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition stands disposed of with the direction that in case the petitioner, with regard to the grievance made in this petition, files a fresh comprehensive representation before the

opposite party no.2 within fifteen days hence, the same shall be considered by the said authority and pass a reasoned and speaking order as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such representation along with the certified copy of this order.
