This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to issue appointment order under Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme as per circular of Bank and decision of Hon'ble Calcutta High Court in favour of the petitioner within a stipulated time.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to the opposite party no.1 vide Annexure-6 series, and the same may be directed to be disposed of within a stipulated time taking into consideration Annexure-4 and 8, to which learned State Counsel has raised no objection.
