01. 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioner being in custody connection with Anandapur P.S. Case No.178 of 2019 corresponding to S.T. Case No.04 of 2020 on the file of learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Anandapur for alleged commission of offence under Section-302 of the IPC read with Section-4 of the D.P. Act, has filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for his release on bail.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
4. Considering the submissions made and on going through the earlier orders as well as the materials on record as placed, while being not inclined to grant bail to the Petitioner. It is however observed that the Trial Court would do well to take all such effective steps as provided in law for conclusion

of the trial as expeditiously as possible in accordance with law within a period of six months hence.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
