01. This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

This is an application under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in connection with Balasore Sadar P.S. Case No.335 of 2021 corresponding to C.T. Case No.875 of 2021 pending in the Court of learned J.M.F.C. (R), Balasore for alleged commission of offences under sections 399/402 of the Indian Penal Code.

In view of available material on record, the nature and gravity of the accusation, while not

inclining to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, it is observed that in the event the petitioner surrenders in the Court below and moves for bail before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be disposed of as expeditiously as possible by the Courts below in accordance with law and claim of parity with the co-accused shall be taken into account at the time of adjudication of the bail application. The case records shall be made available to the Court concerned.

The ABLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
