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1. This matter is taken up through Video Conferencing Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. This is a matter challenging the initiation of a demarcation proceeding vide Annexure-3. For the submission made, this Court is of the opinion that in the event a demarcation process is completed, parties may get peace otherwise. Keeping in view the dispute between the parties, there is no prejudice in the event demarcation case is completed but however involving the petitioner involved herein. In the circumstance this Court while declining to entertain the writ petition observes in the event the Demarcation Case No. 23 of 2021 is still pending in the file of Tahasildar, Oupada, it will be open to the petitioner to participate in such proceeding and get the demarcation concluded.
