2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party no.4 to give appointment to the petitioner against any of the vacant posts of Pharmacist under any scheme/society/regular establishment keeping in view his past experience, within a stipulated time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.4 vide Annexure-6 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, taking into consideration Annexure-5 and 7, to which learned counsel for the State has no objection.
