1. The matter is taken up on through Video Conferencing Mode.
2. Heard Mr.Behera, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.Dayananda Mohapatra, learned counsel for the Development Authority.
3. Looking to the nature of grievance, this Court finds the relief sought for is clearly guided by the bye-law for controlling such executive body. In the circumstance, this Court declines to issue a mandamus against the authority. Petitioner, if so advised, may find out any other option available to him.
4. Consequently, the writ petition stands dismissed.
