This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.

2. Heard.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite party No.2 to release the arrear payable to the late husband of the petitioner in the revised scale of pay of Rs.4900-14680 with grade pay of Rs.1750/- with effect from 01.10.2012 to till her retirement, i.e. 31.01.2013 and accordingly to revise the pension as per ORSP rule, 2008.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made a representation to opposite party No.2 vide Annexure-4 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned counsel for the State has no objection.

5. As agreed to by learned counsel for the parties, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party No.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-4, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified/authenticated copy this

order.
