1. This matter is taken up through virtual mode.

3. Claiming enhanced minimum wages as per Government Circular, the Petitioner has filed a representation vide Annexure-3 before all the Opposite Parties, which is still pending.
4. Regard being had to the facts and submissions and the nature of relief sought for, the writ petition is disposed of directing the Executive Engineer, Rural Works Division-II, Ganjam-Opposite Party No.5 to treat the representation of the Petitioner vide Annexure-3 as one addressed to him and he is further directed to dispose of the representation in accordance with law and relevant notification of the Government by

passing a reasoned order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy or soft copy of this order.

5. The Petitioner is directed to supply the copy of the writ petition containing all the annexures along with certified copy or soft copy of this order to Opposite Party No.5 for convenience and reference to Annexures-3.

6. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
