01. 1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. The Petitioner being in custody in connection with Jankia P.S. Case No.78 of 2021 corresponding to S.T. Case No.21/76 of 2021 arising out of G.R. Case No.432 of 2021 pending in the file of learned CJM-cum-Asst. Sessions Judge, Khurda for commission of offences under section-395 of the Indian Penal Code read with sections 25 of the Arms Act, has filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for his release on bail in the above-mentioned case.
3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned counsel for the State.
4. Taking into account the submissions made; further keeping in view the materials on records with other surrounding circumstances including the factum of grant of bail to the co-accused persons similarly situated with the Petitioner as also the period of detention of the Petitioner in custody and on going

through the order passed by the learned CJM-cum-Asst. Sessions Judge, in the absence of any such impediment; it is directed that the Petitioner be released on bail in the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and proper by the court in seisin of the case with further conditions that Petitioner will not indulge himself in commission of similar type of offences; will appear in person before the Court in seisin of the Case on each date of posting of the case; and will report before the IIC, Godisagada P.S. every Monday in between 10 am to 2 pm for a period of next four months.

5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.

6. As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned Counsel for the parties may utilize a printout of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned Advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587 dated 25th March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798 dated 15th April, 2021 and Court's Office order circulated vide Memo Nos.514 and 515 dated 7th January, 2022.
