1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
 2. The Petitioners being in custody in connection with Banpur P.S. Case No.314 of 2021 corresponding to G.R. Case No.284 of 2021 on the file of learned J.M.F.C., Banpur running for commission of offence under section 395 of the IPC, have filed this application under section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for their release on bail.
 3. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and learned counsel for the State.
 4. Taking into account the submissions made; further keeping in view the materials on records with other surrounding circumstances as also the period of detention of the Petitioners in custody and on going through the order passed by the learned Asst. Sessions Judge; in the absence of any such impediment; it is directed that the Petitioners be released on bail in the aforesaid case on such terms and conditions as deemed just and

proper by the court in seisin of the case with further conditions that:-

1. they will not indulge themselves in any criminal activity;
 2. will appear before the Court in seisin of the case on each date of posting of the case without fail; and
 3. will appear before the IIC, Khallikote P.S. every Monday for a period of next six months.
5. The BLAPL is accordingly disposed of.
6. As the restrictions due to resurgence of COVID-19 situation are continuing, learned Counsel for the parties may utilize a printout of the order available in the High Court's website, at par with certified copy, subject to attestation by the concerned Advocate, in the manner prescribed vide Court's Notice No.4587 dated 25th March, 2020 as modified by Court's Notice No.4798 dated 15th April, 2021 and Court's Office order circulated vide Memo Nos.514 and 515 dated 7th January, 2022.
