1. The matter is taken up on through Video Conferencing Mode.

From the submission of learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, it appears, petitioner is the owner of the land involved and the public authority is attempting to infringe the Civil Right of the petitioning by laying pipeline in the petitioner's land. There is no response to the request of the petitioner, the suffer of the petitioner is manifold. *संबन्धित न्यायो*
4. In the circumstance, this Court observes in the event there is infringement of Civil Right of the petitioner, nothing prevents the petitioner to approach the Civil Court for appropriate remedy even involving the damage, if any.
5. With this observation the writ petition stands disposed of.
