2. Heard Mr. N. Jena, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.
3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to the opposite parties to give higher compensation to him as per current market value against the acquired land with accrued interest minimum @ 8% per annum within a stipulated period.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made a representation to Opposite Party No.3-Sub-Collector-cum-Authorized Officer, Jajpur vide Annexure-4 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time, to which learned counsel for the State has no objection.
