01. 1. This matter is taken up through video conferencing.
2. This is an application under Sec.439 Cr.P.C. for bail and the offence alleged is under Sec.397, I.P.C.
3. Heard Mr. A.Sahoo, learned counsel, on behalf of Mr. S.R. Das, learned counsel for the Petitioner as well as Mr. P.K. Pattanaik, learned A.G.A. for the State-Opposite Party.
4. Having heard both the parties, it reveals that the victim died in the meantime due to the injury sustained on her head in course of commission of offence. It further reveals that the Petitioner has six numbers of criminal antecedents. Considering all such submissions and the materials, I am not inclined to release the Petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected.

5. The BLAPL is dismissed.
