1. This matter is taken up by video conferencing mode.
2. This Civil Miscellaneous Petition is filed seeking a direction for targeting the Title Appeal No.11/18 of 2003.
3. Mr. Sarangi, learned counsel for Petitioner makes a clear statement that for the stage of the appeal, there is requirement of argument only and since there is development in the system of argument, the argument in the Title Appeal No.11/18 of 2003 can be done through video conferencing mode and therefore, Mr. Sarangi, learned counsel for the Petitioner prayed for targeting the Appeal.

Keeping the above statement made by Mr. Sarangi, learned counsel for the Petitioner in view and as the appeal is pending since 2003, this Court directs the 1st Additional District Judge-cum-Special Judge (Vigilance), Bhubaneswar to make an endeavor to conclude the proceeding vide Title Appeal No.11/18 of 2003 within a period of three months from the date of communication of an authenticated copy of

this order by the Petitioner and also ensuring the argument through video conferencing mode.

5. With the aforesaid direction the civil miscellaneous petition stands disposed of.
