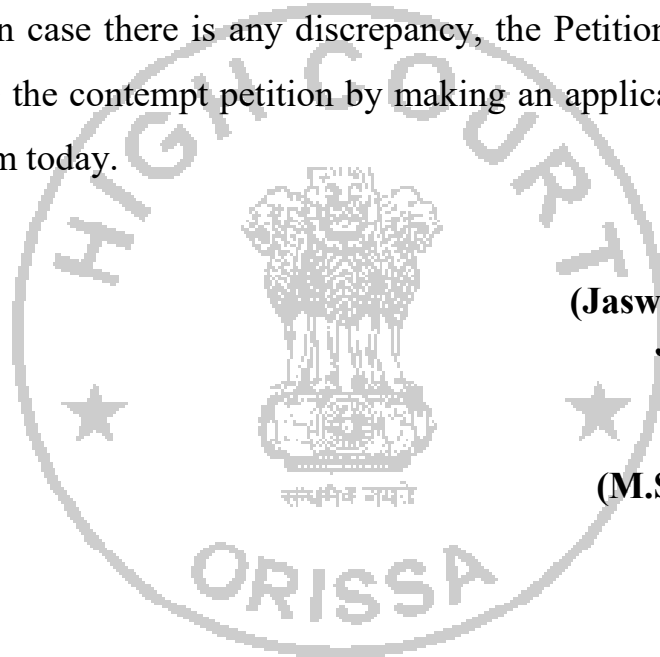
3. This contempt petition has been filed for violation of the order dated 27th January, 2021 passed by this Court in W.P.(C) No. 37272 of 2020.
