2. Heard.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition challenging the order dated 20.12.2016 and seeking direction to the opposite parties to release the pension and other post retiral dues of the petitioner with 18% interest.

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made a representation to opposite party No.1 vide Annexure-7 series and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time.

This being the limited grievance of the petitioner, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party No.1 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-7 series, and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified/authenticated copy this order.
