This matter is taken up through video conferencing mode.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking direction to opposite parties no.1 and 2 to accord approval of his appointment against 1st post of Lecturer in Political Science in Sohela College, Sohela in the district of Bargarh and release his monthly salary/grant-in-aid in his favour taking into account his continuance as a Lecturer in Political Science in the College in question with effect from the date of his appointment within a stipulated period.

4. In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-4 and the same may be directed to be considered within a stipulated time to which learned State

Counsel has no objection.

5. As agreed by the learned counsel for the parties, this Court, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, disposes of the writ petition directing opposite party no.2 to consider the representation filed by the petitioner vide Annexure-4 and pass appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of production of certified copy this order.
