2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner has filed this writ petition to quash the order of suspension dated 06.08.2019 under Annexure-3 and he further seeks direction to the opposite parties to reinstate him with all consequential benefits and further seeks direction to opposite party no.2 to release his subsistence allowance during suspension period.

In course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner states that highlighting the grievances, the petitioner has made representation to opposite party no.2 vide Annexure-6 series and the same may be directed to be considered taking into consideration Annexure-5 within a stipulated time to which learned State Counsel has no objection.
