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1. This matter is taken up through Video Conferencing Mode.
2. Heard learned counsel appearing for the parties.
3. There is allegation that in spite of repeated memos, R.P.Case No.260 of 2019 has not been admitted as of now. Provided there is no serious defect required to be removed by the petitioner in order to make the R.P.Case entertainable and a memo being filed within a period of seven days hence by the petitioner, the matter will be taken up for admission at least within a period of seven days thereafter.
4. With this observation and direction, the writ petition stands disposed of.
