PER COURT :

1. It is an application moved by the objection petitioners seeking permission to bring on record legal heirs of owner of the vehicle.
2. Heard Mr Maney, learned counsel for objection petitioners, Mr A.G. Kanade, learned counsel for respondent No.1/insurance company and Ms Pratibha Bharad, learned counsel for original claimants.
