PER COURT:-

1. It is an application for condonation of delay moved by the applicant / original claimant.
2. Heard Mr. Atul Muley holding for Mr. M.P. Kale, learned counsel for the applicant.
3. On perusing the record, it is evident that there is a delay of 9 days in preferring the first appeal.
4. By looking to the volume of delay and considering the reasons assigned in para 2 of the application, it is necessary to condone the delay.
