FINAL ORDER :

3. The petitioner shall surrender the original tribe certificate with the Sub divisional Officer, Degloor. The Sub Divisional Officer, Degloor shall within a period of five (05) days from submission of the original tribe certificate issue the tribe

certificate in the format as prescribed by the Central Government.

4. In the light of the above, the writ petition is disposed of.
