1 It appears that the Registry has put this case by registering the case under the caption “Criminal Writ Petition”, but if we consider the contents of the letter that was given by the under trial that he is seeking relaxation of the condition imposed while granting bail to him in Bail Application No.633/2021. Therefore, Registry to re-register the application under correct caption. The applicant who is under trial should be represented by a competent Advocate and, therefore, learned Advocate Mr. P.P.
