IN CIVIL APPLICATION NO.17180 OF 2022 :

1. Heard rival submissions.
2. Considering the grounds of challenge by the insurance company in the appeal, the applicant is permitted to withdraw only 50% of the deposited amount alongwith the interest at this juncture. The remaining amount be invested in FDR in any nationalized Bank on yearly renewal basis till final disposal of this appeal. The application is accordingly disposed of.

IN CIVIL APPLICATION FOR 13243 OF 2019 :

1. Heard rival submissions.
2. The insurance company, who has filed this appeal is seeking condonation of delay of 108 days. There is no strong oppose from

the other side. As such, the delay of 108 days stands condoned and application is disposed of. The appeal be placed for admission after removal of office objection, if any.

IN CIVIL APPLICATION NO.13247 OF 2019 :

Since the applicant / appellant insurance company has deposited entire amount of compensation, application is made absolute in terms of prayer clause-B and disposed of accordingly.
