PER COURT :-

1. The Competent Authorities of the Bank have been arrayed as respondent Nos. 2, 3 and 4.
2. The learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that the Chairman of State Bank of India need not to be arrayed as respondent. He has filed Civil Application No. 632 of 2021 for seeking deletion.
