PER COURT :-

This is a Civil Application for withdrawal of the amount deposited pursuant to the condition imposed while granting ad-interim relief.

2. The Second Appeal was withdrawn unconditionally and by the order dated 15.01.2021 the appellants were granted liberty to apply for refund of the amounts.

3. I have heard learned Advocate Mr. Malte for the original appellant and Mr. Rane learned Advocate for the original respondents.
