1 After making submissions for a while, when disinclination is shown and also when it was asked, as to why the applicant had not approached the Court, which granted the bail for its cancellation on the ground of alleged breach of terms of bail, learned Advocate for the applicant prays for withdrawal of the application with liberty to approach the same Court. Taking into consideration the point which the applicant wants to agitate that alleged breach of terms of bail, the liberty is granted to this

limited extent, only to the applicant to approach the same Court, under Section 439(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.
