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PER COURT :-

1. None appears for the respondents inspite of service of notice.
2. Heard the learned Advocate for the applicant.
3. This is an application seeking condonation of delay of four days that is caused in filing an application for restoration of ALP No.225 of 2018 which was dismissed for default as steps were not taken by the learned Advocate for the applicant.
4. Learned Advocate for the applicant undertakes that, he will remove the office objections within a period of two weeks from today, if ALP is restored. He submits that ALP is filed against the order of acquittal for the

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offence u/s 420, 468, 471 r/w 34 of the IPC. He submits that, there is merit in his ALP, however, because of non-removal of office objections, he is not in a position to pursue it.

5. Considering the submissions, delay of four days is condoned. ALP No.225 of 2018 is restored to its file. The learned Advocate to remove office objections in ALP within a period of two weeks from today. Criminal application is disposed off.
