- . This Civil Application is filed for bringing on record legal heirs of deceased respondent No.1.
2. Ms. Rekha Choudhari – learned Counsel holding for learned Counsel - Mr. S.S. Choudhari states that, she has instructions to appear for the proposed legal heirs of deceased respondent No.1.
3. There is delay of 2384 days in filing this application. The Counsel for respondent Nos.1-A to 1-C and 2 opposes

The Division Bench of this Court in **Keshao Kawadu Maral and another Versus State of Maharashtra**, reported in 2005 (supp.) B.C.R. 226, condoned the delay of six years in filing the application for bringing legal heirs on record relying upon judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Sardar Amarjit Singh Kalra (Died) by LRs and others Versus Pramod Gupta (Smt.) Dead) by Lrs. And others**, reported in (2003) 3 SCC 272.

5. Relying upon the above judgments and for the reasons stated in the civil application, civil application is allowed in terms of prayer clause 'b'.

6. The Civil Application is disposed off.
