2. Mr. Bachate, learned counsel for the petitioner states that appeal filed by the petitioner dated 18.01.2022 is pending before the authority. He invited our attention to order dated 09.03.2022 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in Writ Petition No. 3358 of 2022 in a case of Rashtramata Maa Jijau Sevabhavi Sanstha Vs. The State of Maharashtra and others and submits that in identical matter this Court has directed the appellate authority to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner therein expeditiously and preferably within a period of fifteen days from the date of appearance of the petitioner. He submits
