PER COURT :

1. Learned counsel for the respondents points out that there is alternate remedy of preferring revision before the State Government under Section 154 of the Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will prefer revision before the State Government as mandated under Section 154 of the Maharashtra Co-operative Societies Act. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the delay caused in pursuing this petition may be condoned.
