PER COURT :

1. These are the applications for condonation of delay moved by the applicants/claimants.
2. Heard Mr A.D. Pawar, learned counsel for the applicant/acquiring body and Mr A.B. Kale, learned counsel for the respondents/original claimants.

3. Mr Kale, learned counsel for the respondents/original claimants has strongly opposed to condone the delay on the ground that no sufficient reasons are assigned by the acquiring body for condonation of delay.
