By this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek an order and direction against respondent nos.3 and 4 to give posting to the petitioners as per Circular dated 28.06.2018 issued by respondent no.1 or in the alternative to consider the claims/representations of the petitioners annexed at Exhibit-C to the petition.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioners now pressed only alternate prayer i.e. prayer Clause (C) that the claims/representations of the petitioners be decided by Zilla Parishad on or before 05.05.2022.
