Heard rival submissions. The respective applicants are seeking condonation of delay periods as mentioned in both these applications. The delay appears to be caused due to financial crisis of the applicants. The learned AGP strongly opposed the applications on the ground that there is also circulation delay. The respondent No. 3 - Acquiring Body though served, but remained absent.

2. However, considering the statutory right of the applicants, the respective delay periods mentioned in these applications stand condoned subject to condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the aforesaid delay periods and also for delay in circulating the matter belatedly.

3. The appeals be placed for admission after removal of office objections, if any.

4. The applications are accordingly disposed of.
