2. Heard.

3. The applicant has been convicted for the offence punishable under Section 363 of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for three years and to pay fine of Rs.500/-, in default to suffer simple imprisonment for one week. He has further been convicted for the offence punishable under Section 12 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for one

year and to pay fine of Rs.500/-, in default to suffer further simple imprisonment for one week.

4. Considering the quantum of sentence imposed and the fact that the appeal is not likely to be heard in near future, the execution of substantive sentence of imprisonment to stand suspended pending the appeal. The applicant be released on his executing P.R. bond in the sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with surety in the like amount.

5. Criminal application stands disposed of.
