Heard learned counsel for the applicants, learned AGP and learned counsel for respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the applicants submits that this Court (Coram R.G. Avachat J.) has allowed to withdrawal of 75% amount in connected appeals. Hence applicants be permitted to withdraw the amount.

3. Considering the submissions of both the learned counsel and order passed by this Court in connected group of

appeals, applicants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the deposited amount on furnishing usual undertaking and 25% of the amount be paid on furnishing solvent surety/ security/Bank guarantee. Balance 25% amount be invested in Fixed Deposit in any nationalized Bank, till the disposal of the appeal.
