ORDER :

1. This application is filed seeking extension of time of six weeks for compliance of the condition of depositing 50% amount of the recovery certificate.
2. It is the contention of the applicant that he is a government contractor and his bills are outstanding. By now, the applicant has deposited an amount of Rs.6,00,000/-. However, Rs.6,00,000/- more amount is required to be deposited by the applicant. The recovery certificate for Rs.21,50,844/- plus interest at the rate of 14% per annum is issued against him.

3. The learned Advocate for the respondent/bank states that the request of the applicant for installments towards re-payment of the dues is in consideration of the bank.
4. In that view of the matter, the applicant is granted four weeks time to deposit the balance amount of 50% of the recovery certificate.
5. Civil Application is disposed of accordingly.
