ORDER:-

1. Heard rival submissions. The applicants are seeking condonation of delay of 1417 days in filing the appeal. The delay appears to be caused due to their financial crisis. The learned A.G.P. strongly opposed the application on the ground that there is also circulation delay. The Acquiring Body, though served, but remained absent. However, considering the statutory right of the applicants, the delay of 1417 days stands condoned subject to condition that the applicants shall not claim any interest for the aforesaid delay period and also for the delay in circulating the matter belatedly.

2. The appeal be placed for admission after removal of office objections.
3. The Civil Application is disposed of accordingly.
