. Heard learned counsel for applicants, learned AGP for respondent-State and learned counsel for respondent No.3.

2. Learned counsel for applicants submits that, in connected group of matters, this Court has permitted the respondents to withdraw the 60 % amount i.e. Civil Application No. 4180/2021. Hence the same order be passed in this matter.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No. 3 has not disputed the fact that this Court has allowed the claimants in

connected matters to withdraw the amount. Hence, I pass the following order :

O R D E R

- (i) The applicants - claimants are permitted to withdraw 40% of the deposited amount on submitting an undertaking to the satisfaction of the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.
- (ii) The applicants are permitted to withdraw further 20% of the deposited amount on submitting solvent surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.
- (iii) Balance 40% amount be invested in the Fixed Deposit Receipt in any Nationalised Bank for the period till disposal of the appeal.
- (iv) The application for withdrawal of the amount stands disposed of.
