Heard.

2. The applicant/appellant herein has been convicted for the offence punishable under Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, Section 376(1) read with Section 511, and Section 354-B of Indian Penal Code and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for three years and to pay a fine of Rs.500/-, in default, to suffer simple imprisonment for two months. The applicant/appellant has further been convicted for the offence

punishable under Section 506(II) of Indian Penal Code and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for two years and to pay a fine of Rs.500/-, in default, to suffer simple imprisonment for two months.

3. Considering the quantum of sentence imposed and the fact that the appeal is not likely to come up for hearing in the near future, during pendency of the appeal, the substantive sentence of imprisonment to stand suspended. The applicant be released on executing P.R. Bond in the sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with one surety in the like amount.

4. The application stands disposed of.
