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**PER COURT :-**

1. Mr. Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to place on record the copy of the amicable settlement/agreement between the parties with copies of Aadhar Cards and copy of the Demand Draft.

2. Leave granted. The documents are taken on record and marked 'X' collectively for identification.

3. Mr. Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner and Miss Bhingardev learned counsel for respondent no.1 submit that the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled. Parties have withdrawn the cases filed by each other. Respondent no.2 has given demand draft of Rs.1,50,000/- to the petitioner. As such, learned

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counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for respondent no.1 as well submit that the petition can be disposed off in view of amicable settlement between the parties.

4. Mr. Sanap, learned APP for the State has no objection to dispose off this petition in view of terms of settlement arrived at between the parties.

5. Having regard to the submissions of learned counsel for both sides and learned APP for the State and in view of the amicable settlement between the petitioner and respondent no.1, this petition stands disposed off. No order as to costs. Pending criminal application, if any, also stands disposed off.
