PER COURT :

1. Heard Mr M.M.Bhokarikar, learned Advocate for applicants and Mr A.B. Chate, learned A.G.P. for respondent no.2/S.L.A.O. None present for respondent no.1 when matter is called out.
2. There is delay of 199 days in preferring the appeal.
3. For the reasons stated in the application in paragraphs 4 and 5 and in view of citation in case of **Ningappa Thotappa Angadi (Dead) through L.Rs. Vs. The Special Land Acquisition Officer**, reported in **MANU/SC/1745/2019**, the delay needs to be condoned.

ORDER

- (i) The Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (B).
- (ii) The applicants/claimants shall furnish undertaking with the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court stating that they would not claim statutory benefits and interest in respect of delayed period, which is condoned today.
