Heard learned counsel for the applicant and respondent No.1.

2. It is contention of the learned counsel of the applicant that in connected matters this Court has allowed to withdraw 75% amount to the applicant in those matters.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 submits that applicant No.2 and 3 are minor hence their amount cannot be withdrawn by the applicant No.1.

4. Considering the reasons mentioned in the application, the applicant No.1 is permitted to withdraw 30% of

the deposited amount. She is also permitted to withdraw interest on rest of the deposited amount after three months for the education purpose of applicant Nos. 2 and 3.

5. Civil Application is disposed of.
