Per Court :-

1. The petitioner has put forth prayer clauses B and C
as under :-

- “B. By way of appropriate writ, order or direction in the like nature, the respondent no.2 may kindly be directed to decide the application dated 17.05.2022 and 20.10.2021 made by the petitioner in the form of complaint by setting aside the communication/ letter dated 04.05.2022.
- C. Pending hearing & final disposal of this writ petition, the respondent No.5 may please be restrained from conducting the business & participating the day to day activities of Grampanchayat Chinchkhede, Tq. & Dist. Dhule till the inquiry into the complaint made by the petitioner is completed.”

2. We have considered the submissions of the learned advocate for the petitioner and the learned AGP on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2. We have gone through the petition paper book with their assistance. Since the petitioner desires to lodge a specific complaint against respondent No.5 as he alleges that he has performed two marriages, he has more than two children, he has grabbed government grants, etc., the learned advocate submits that the petitioner would be preferring independent complaints to appropriate authorities.

3. In view of the above, this Writ Petition is disposed off. If the petitioner lodges the complaints, if so permissible in law, it is left open to the authorities to deal with such complaints in accordance with law.
