**PER COURT :**

1. These are the applications for condonation of delay moved by the applicants/acquiring body.

2. Heard Mr S.G. Karlekar, learned counsel for the applicants/acquiring body and Mr R.D. Biradar, learned counsel for the respondent/original claimant in respective applications.
3. There seems to be delay of 782 days in preferring the appeals in all the matters.
