ORDER:-

1. The applicants are claiming condonation of delay of 2949 days in filing the first appeal. The learned Counsel for the applicants submits that in other similar matters, the delay has already been condoned. The learned Counsel for respondent No. 3 – Acquiring Body has also not disputed the said position.
