Heard rival submissions.

2. The respective applicants are seeking withdrawal of entire amounts of compensation as deposited by the State / Acquiring Body.

3. The learned AGP pointed out that the Reference Court has granted six times enhancement in all these matters. As such,

considering the ratio of four times 70% of the deposited amounts can be allowed to be withdrawn by the respective applicants. As such, following order is passed :

ORDER

- (i) The respective applicants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the deposited amounts along with the accrued interest thereon till date by furnishing usual undertaking before the learned Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.
 - (ii) The applicants are also permitted to withdraw 20% of the deposited amounts on furnishing solvent security / surety. The remaining amounts be invested in any Nationalized Bank in F.D.R. on yearly renewal basis till final disposal of these appeals.
4. The applications are disposed of accordingly.
