Learned APP, on instructions in writing from the Office of Police Superintendent, Ahmednagar (Economic Wing), submits that on the basis of complaint filed by the petitioner herein, Crime No. 121 of 2022 came to be registered at Kotwali Police Station, Ahmednagar for the offence punishable under Sections 409, 420, 467, 468 and 471 read with 34 of IPC. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the registration of the crime nothing survives for further consideration in this writ petition.
