1. Heard the learned counsel for the applicant and learned APP for the respondent / State.

2. The facts have been discussed in the order dated 18.07.2022. The applicant Ketan Shah was the friend of the complainant. He and his son introduced the other co-accused to the informant. They were trading in caustic soda. The complainant and the other co-accused were trading in caustic Soda. However, the transaction could not be completed. The case under Section 138 also filed against the co-accused.

3. Considering the alleged role attributed to the applicants, the prosecution appears to have no material to have the

custodial interrogation of the applicants. Hence, the application deserves to be allowed. Hence, the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The application is allowed.
- (ii) The interim protection granted to both the applicants by an order dated 18.07.2022 stands confirmed on the same terms and conditions.
